What: The Young Curators programme runs for six months, with a 2 hour session taking place at the Harlow Playhouse/Gibberd Gallery each week, some extra hours maybe required during the creation of an art exhibition in the Gibberd Gallery.

Aim: To provide vocational experience and training for students and offer professional development for young people to extend their art practice and enhance potential career paths

There will be high-level support and guidance from the experienced young curators team.

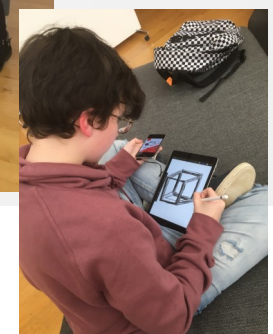
